University of Maryland, Hudson National receive top honors for Renovation of the Year

University of Maryland Golf Course won first place in the Golf Inc. Renovation of the Year Competition, with Hudson National Golf Club winning for projects under \$1 million and Saucon Valley Country Club taking top honors for private clubs over \$1 million.

Brian Kington and Bill Love, who grew up playing on the University of Maryland course, were the lead architects behind the renovation. Wadsworth Golf Construction handled the \$3.5 million construction. The university owned course beat out stiff competition from across the world to win the 'best of competition' honor.
